- Festival is held Rain or Shine.
- The Maple Park Fun Fest does not guarantee crafter sales.
- Hours of Operation: **Saturday, September 5th**, Crafters are allowed to sell from **10:00 am to 8:00 pm.**
- You may begin setting up at 8:00 am. (Bands and activities will occur throughout the day.)
- You are responsible for bringing chairs, tables, canopies, and anything else you may need to set up your area.
- Vendors are required to find a garbage can at the end of the event and dispose of booth garbage properly.
- Vendors can only sell from their rented booth space. We do not allow walking on the grounds selling merchandise or handing out fliers.
- All Crafters are responsible for maintaining their space in a manner that is both safe and pleasing to their workers and customers. All trash must be boxed or bagged and placed in the containers provided. No liquid waste can be discharged on the grounds. Crafters are responsible for removing their own property and cleaning their own space at the close of the festival.
- Crafters will occupy open spaces on the street (not the sidewalk) in front of non-participating businesses and on side streets.
